Canvassing Board Minutes**

**Present:** Clerk Yenter, Liz Fulton, Kevin Knitt.

**1. Canvass provisional ballots for the April 6, 2021 Spring Election.**

Clerk Yenter said there was one provisional ballot that was cast in the sixth district. She said the voter did come back and show proof of id.

The committee reviewed the documents for the provisional voter.

Clerk Yenter opened ballot bag number 00139907 and the provisional ballot envelope.

The committee processed the provisional ballot, agreed that the tallies were correct and adjusted the tape to reflect the votes accordingly.

The voter was assigned voter number 445 at the polls on Election Day. The committee chose to keep the voter number that was assigned on Election Day.

The committee sealed the ballot in ballot bag number 00140183 and updated the Inspector Statement. The Board of Canvass members signed the ballot bag and paperwork for processing the provisional ballot.

**2. Canvass City Races: City Clerk, Comptroller/Treasurer, City Attorney, Odd Numbered Aldermanic Districts.**

In District #1, after review of the materials, the committee determined the results to be as follows: City Clerk Kari Yenter received 212 votes, City Comptroller/Treasurer Corey D. Ladick received 207 votes, City Attorney Andrew Beveridge received 200 votes, District #1 Alderperson Tori Jennings received 204 votes.

In District #2, after review of the materials, the committee determined the results to be as follows: City Clerk Kari Yenter received 149 votes, City Comptroller/Treasurer Corey D. Ladick received 154 votes, City Attorney Andrew Beveridge received 141 votes.

In District #3, after review of the materials, the committee determined the results to be as follows: City Clerk Kari Yenter received 125 votes, City Comptroller/Treasurer Corey D. Ladick received 132 votes, City Attorney Andrew Beveridge received 119 votes, District #3 Alderperson Ginger Keymer received 126 votes.

In District #4, after review of the materials, the committee determined the results to be as follows: City Clerk Kari Yenter received 188 votes, City Comptroller/Treasurer Corey D. Ladick received 179 votes, City Attorney Andrew Beveridge received 174 votes.

In District #5, after review of the materials, the committee determined the results to be as follows: City Clerk Kari Yenter received 319 votes, City Comptroller/Treasurer Corey D. Ladick received 313 votes,

City Attorney Andrew Beveridge received 312 votes, District #5 Alderperson Marla Schultz received 168 votes, Meleesa Johnson received 257 votes, Write-In Tyler Paterick received 3 votes.

In District #6, after review of the materials, the committee determined the results to be as follows: City Clerk Kari Yenter received 335 votes, City Comptroller/Treasurer Corey D. Ladick received 344 votes, City Attorney Andrew Beveridge received 312 votes.

In District #7, after review of the materials, the committee determined the results to be as follows: City Clerk Kari Yenter received 213 votes, City Comptroller/Treasurer Corey D. Ladick received 208 votes, City Attorney Andrew Beveridge received 200 votes, District #7 Alderperson Mary Kneebone received 201 votes.

In District #8, after review of the materials, the committee determined the results to be as follows: City Clerk Kari Yenter received 338 votes, City Comptroller/Treasurer Corey D. Ladick received 343 votes, City Attorney Andrew Beveridge received 320 votes.

In District #9, after review of the materials, the committee determined the results to be as follows: City Clerk Kari Yenter received 246 votes, City Comptroller/Treasurer Corey D. Ladick received 232 votes, City Attorney Andrew Beveridge received 236 votes, District #9 Alderperson Brian Beaulieu received 154 votes, Polly Dalton received 201 votes.

In District #10, after review of the materials, the committee determined the results to be as follows: City Clerk Kari Yenter received 221 votes, City Comptroller/Treasurer Corey D. Ladick received 216 votes, City Attorney Andrew Beveridge received 216 votes.

In District #11, after review of the materials, the committee determined the results to be as follows: City Clerk Kari Yenter received 97 votes, City Comptroller/Treasurer Corey D. Ladick received 98 votes, City Attorney Andrew Beveridge received 95 votes, District #11 Alderperson Shaun Morrow received 100 votes.

In summary for the City Offices: City Clerk Kari Yenter 2,443 votes, City Comptroller/Treasurer Corey D. Ladick 2,426 votes, City Attorney Andrew Beveridge 2,325 votes, District #1 Alderperson Tori Jennings 204 votes, District #3 Alderperson Ginger Keymer 126 votes, District #5 Alderperson Meleesa Johnson 257 votes, District #7 Alderperson Mary Kneebone 201 votes, District #9 Alderperson Polly Dalton 201 votes, District #11 Alderperson Shaun Morrow 100 votes.

The committee certified the results of the canvass.
