Re: City of Stevens Point Redistricting

The Redistricting process has reached stage 3 – Reconciliation. Discrepancies were found between the city ward boundaries and Portage County supervisory district boundaries that need to be corrected. The city ward boundaries were corrected and adjusted as shown on the map labeled REDRAWB. This new map of the ward boundaries will need to be approved by the Committee for recommendation to the Council for approval. Portage County plans to adjust their boundary lines at their Redistricting Committee meeting being held on November 1, 2021.
