3. The local food fair is a special event that has been held at Sentry's facility for many years. This event has the potential to draw upwards of 3,000 people and the event organizers are seeking to move it outside in Pfiffner Park. The event would run rain or shine on Saturday, May 7 but set up would include set up for multiple days beginning May 5 and clean up ending on May 8. The event organizers would also be renting the Pfiffner Building to allow the green space between the bandshell and Pfiffner building to be used for their event staging. Insurance will be provided by the applicant. The fee for this special event is as follows:

4 days @\$250 for bandshell and lawn - \$1,000
1 day of electricity for vendors - \$100
2 days of Pfiffner Building Rental - \$500
Cleaning supplies/materials - \$200

Total: \$1,800

Staff recommendation is to approve the special event as proposed

4. The fees and charges schedule for the PRF Department is included in the packet as two files. The first file includes the red lines and edits which are being proposed. The second file is the version without redlines and edits. You will notice that increases are not proposed for 2022. With the recent changes in staff, the 2022 fee and charges schedule consist primarily of updates to reflect what is currently being charged. We discovered some areas where price increases were not incorporated correctly from previous years. Additionally, with the implementation of the online reservation system, our department is experiencing increases in revenue for lodges and gym/meeting room rentals. Details below

Last year there was also a discussion regarding non-resident fees. Currently, we have non-resident fees for boat slips, pool passes and skating programs. The fee varies slightly (\$10.00 per program, \$25 per pass, \$100 per boat slip). Staff will ask for direction from the Park Commission on if the board wishes to see a universal non-resident fee created for lodge rentals and other facility fees.

Staff recommendation is to approve the 2022 fees and charges schedule as proposed and provide direction to staff on the non-resident fee policy creation.

5. Since the October meeting, the Programs and Facility Supervisor position was vacant after the previous team member accepted another position. Following advertisement and the interview process, Anne Hylla has accepted the position and began her duties on November 3. The department is now in the hiring process for a new administrative assistant. The goal is to fill this position by the 1st of the year.

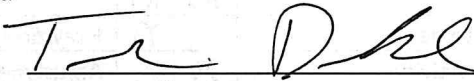
