Canvassing Board Minutes**

1. Verify no provisional ballots for the April 5, 2022, Spring Election.

The committee verified there were no provisional voters in each district.

2. Canvass the municipal results for District 1 Alderperson and all even numbered District Alderpersons, and if necessary correct any errors or irregularities, as a result of such canvass.

In District 1, after review of the materials, the committee verified there were a total of 391 votes. The committee determined the results to be as follows for District 1: Marc Christianson received 272 votes, Stephen Klein received 118 votes, 1 scattering.

In District 2, Wards 4 & 5, after review of the materials, the committee verified there were a total of 313 votes. The committee determined the results to be as follows for District 2 (Wards 4 & 5): David Shorr received 205 votes, Corey Kealiher received 107 votes, 1 scattering.

In District 2, Ward 6, after review of the materials, the committee verified there were a total of 95 votes. The committee determined the results to be as follows for District 2 (Ward 6): David Shorr received 71 votes, Corey Kealiher received 24 votes.

In District 4, Wards 10 & 11, after review of the materials, the committee verified there were a total of 290 votes. The committee determined the results to be as follows for District 4 (Wards 10 & 11): David Crueger received 107 votes, Mykeerah Zarazua received 183 votes.

In District 4, Ward 12, after review of the materials, the committee verified there were a total of 143 votes. The committee determined the results to be as follows for District 4 (Ward 12): David Crueger received 73 votes, Mykeerah Zarazua received 70 votes.

In District 6, after review of the materials, the committee verified there were a total of 520 votes. The committee determined the results to be as follows for District 6: Ron Carlson received 511 votes, 9 scattering.

In District 8, after review of the materials, the committee verified there were a total of 742 votes. The committee determined the results to be as follows for District 8: Thomas Leek received 361 votes, Dean Shuda received 381 votes.

In District 10, Ward 28, after review of the materials, the committee verified there were a total of 266 votes. The committee determined the result to be as follows for District 10 (Ward 28): Keely Fishler received 127 votes, Robert Larson received 139 votes.

In District 10, Ward 29, after review of the materials, the committee verified there were a total of 43 votes. The committee determined the result to be as follows for District 10 (Ward 29): Keely Fishler received 25 votes, Robert Larson received 18 votes.

In District 10, Ward 30, after review of the materials, the committee verified there were a total of 163 votes. The committee determined the result to be as follows for District 10 (Ward 30): Keely Fishler received 89 votes, Robert Larson received 74 votes.
