**1. Verify no provisional ballots for the August 9, 2022 Partisan Primary Election.**

The committee verified there were no provisional voters in each district.

**2. Canvass the results for the municipal referendum, and if necessary correct any errors or irregularities, as a result of such canvass.**

In District 1, after review of the materials, the committee verified there were a total of 489 votes. The committee determined the results to be as follows for District 1 Referendum: Yes received 158 votes, No received 261 votes.

In District 2, after review of the materials, the committee verified there were a total of 502 votes. The committee determined the results to be as follows for District 2 Referendum: Yes received 189 votes, No received 262 votes.

In District 3, after review of the materials, the committee verified there were a total of 355 votes. The committee determined the results to be as follows for District 3 Referendum: Yes received 138 votes, No received 192 votes.

In District 4, after review of the materials, the committee verified there were a total of 501 votes. The committee determined the results to be as follows for District 4 Referendum: Yes received 228 votes, No received 206 votes.

In District 5, after review of the materials, the committee verified there were a total of 633 votes. The committee determined the results to be as follows for District 5 Referendum: Yes received 311 votes, No received 281 votes.

In District 6, after review of the materials, the committee verified there were a total of 870 votes. The committee determined the results to be as follows for District 6

Referendum: Yes received 436 votes, No received 381 votes.

In District 7, after review of the materials, the committee verified there were a total of 506 votes. The committee determined the result to be as follows for District 7  
Referendum: Yes received 251 votes, No received 192 votes.

In District 8, after review of the materials, the committee verified there were a total of 786 votes. The committee determined the result to be as follows for District 8  
Referendum: Yes received 332 votes, No received 373 votes.

In District 9, after review of the materials, the committee verified there were a total of 616 votes. The committee determined the result to be as follows for District 9  
Referendum: Yes received 281 votes, No received 267 votes.

In District 10, after review of the materials, the committee verified there were a total of 619 votes. The committee determined the result to be as follows for District 10  
Referendum: Yes received 329 votes, No received 232 votes.

In District 11, after review of the materials, the committee verified there were a total of 221 votes. The committee determined the result to be as follows for District 11  
Referendum: Yes received 104 votes, No received 79 votes.
