ORDINANCE AMENDING THE REVISED MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF STEVENS POINT, WISCONSIN

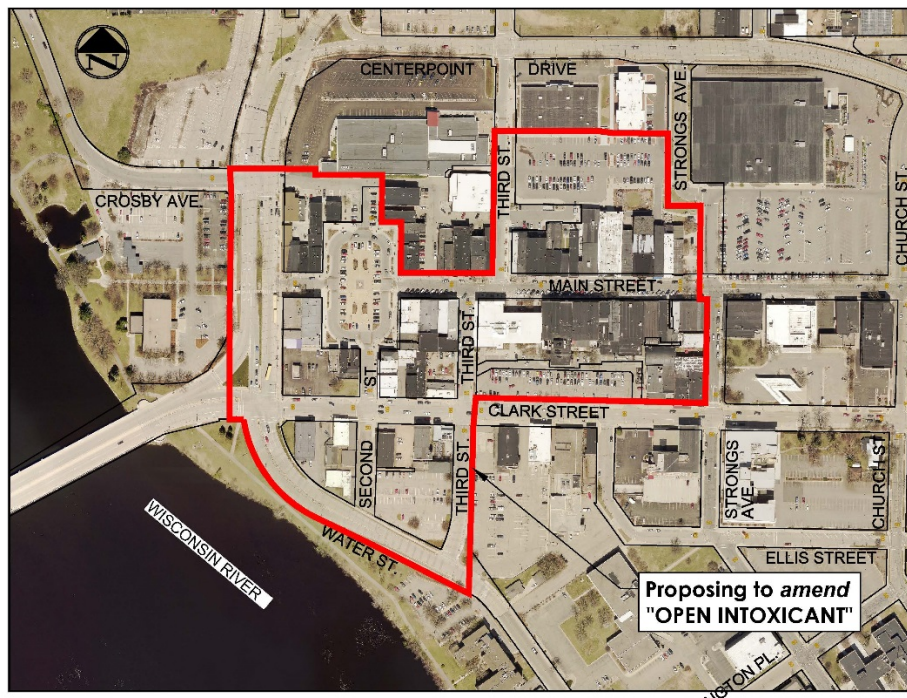
The Common Council of the City of Stevens Point do ordain as follows:

SECTION I: That subsection 24.03 of the Revised Municipal Code, Possession of or Drinking Fermented Malt Beverages or Intoxicating Liquor on Public Ways, is hereby **amended** to read as follows:

24.03 POSSESSION OF OR DRINKING FERMENTED MALT BEVERAGES OR INTOXICATING LIQUOR ON PUBLIC WAYS. Whoever has in his/her possession any open can, bottle, or other vessel containing malt beverages or intoxicating liquor, or who shall drink from the same on any public way, public street, sidewalk, boulevard, parkway, safety zone, alley or public parking lot, or on and/or in any motor vehicle parked on a public way, public street, alley, or parking lot shall suffer a forfeiture not to exceed \$100 and in lieu of such payment assessed, imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days in the county jail. ~~The exception being that, at such times and such places as may be specifically excepted temporarily from the provisions hereof by order of the common council.~~

The Common Council may from time to time authorize exceptions to this Section for specific times and places. Such exceptions may be ordered as part of a Special Events Permit issued under RMC 12.28 or as an order issued by the Common Council under this Section. If such an order is incorporated as part of a Special Events Permit, the City Clerk's Office is authorized to approve the exception for any future repeats of the same special event, provided that such Special Events Permit does not otherwise require approval by the Common Council pursuant to the provisions of RMC 12.28.

This Section shall not apply to the Downtown area as defined in the image below. This exception shall apply from 12:00 P.M. until 9:00 P.M. daily. This exception shall not apply to glass containers.



SECTION II: This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication, as provided by law.
