FROM: Mayor Wiza and Municipal Court Oversight Committee

RE: Municipal Court Judge Salary

Salary for elected officials needs to be set for any upcoming term. The position of Municipal Court Judge is scheduled for an April 2024 election.

The Oversight Committee met and voted for a 3% increase for each year of the upcoming term. This salary comes from the Joint Municipal Court Budget, not the City or Village budget and also must be approved by the Plover Village Board.

Salary for this position must be set for the entire term (4 years) and we've included a consistent 3% increase for each subsequent year for the term.

Therefore, the Joint Municipal Court Oversight Committee requests that the salaries for Municipal Court Judge be set as follow for the upcoming term:

Starting on 5/1/2024 \$17,749.00

Starting on 5/1/2025 \$18,281.00

Starting on 5/1/2026 \$18,830.00

Starting on 5/1/2027 \$19,395.00
