B. Supporting Our Police Dept., October 25, 2020 (New)

Jane Blanchard, 6828 Highway 66, said they are still in the planning stages of the event. They are looking at having the event on the sidewalks around the courthouse, and will be encouraging masks and social distancing.

Mayor Wiza said if the event is people standing on sidewalks showing support, a special event permit is not needed.

4. Discussion and creation of a panel charged with producing an overnight parking policy.

Ald. Nebel **moved**, Ald. Kneebone seconded, to approve a committee being setup.

Nancy Roppe, 925 Smith Street, spoke against the creation of the committee. She said there is an existing overnight street parking rules and they should be left as is.

Joe Roppe, 925 Smith Street, spoke against allowing free overnight stre parking. He provided examples and pictures of student rentals on Smith Street and why free overnight parking on Smith Street should be avoided.

Bob Woehr, 727 Second Street, thought this was a discussion only item, and said a motion and vote should not be taken if its discussion only.

Mayor Wiza said this agenda item does not say discussion only, and the motion is acceptable.
