ORDINANCE AMENDING THE REVISED MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF STEVENS POINT, WISCONSIN

The Common Council of the City of Stevens Point do ordain as follows:

SECTION I: That subsection (g) of Section 33.03 of the Revised Municipal Code, is hereby **created** to read as follows:

(g) Qualification. No person shall be appointed under Subsection 33.03(a) nor be eligible to run for election under Subsection 33.03(c) unless such person is an attorney who is a member of the Wisconsin Bar in good standing with the same.

SECTION II: That subsection Section 33.05(e) of the Revised Municipal Code, Municipal Court Procedures, is hereby **amended** to read as follows:

(e) The municipal judge may issue civil warrants to enforce matters which are under the jurisdiction of the municipal court. The municipal judge is also authorized to issue inspection warrants under Wisconsin Statutes § 66.0119.sections 66.122 and 66.123 of the Wisconsin Statutes.

SECTION III: That subsection Section 33.05(f) of the Revised Municipal Code, Municipal Court Procedures, is hereby **amended** to read as follows:

(f) The municipal judge may impose such forfeitures as may be enumerated in the Wisconsin Statutes, the City of Stevens Point ordinances, and the Village of Plover ordinances. Court fees may also be imposed and shall be the maximum amount allowed under Wisconsin Statutes § 814.65(1) or its successor statute. ~~in the amounts approved by the Stevens Point Common Council and the Plover Board of Village Trustees.~~

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE REVISED MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF STEVENS POINT, WISCONSIN

The Common Council of the City of Stevens Point do ordain as follows:

SECTION I: That subsection 24.01(5) of the Revised Municipal Code, Prohibited Use of 911 System, is hereby **created** to read as follows:

(5) PROHIBITED USE OF 911 SYSTEM.

- (a) It shall be unlawful to intentionally dial the emergency telephone number “911” to report an emergency knowing that the factual situation the caller describes to the 911 operator does not exist.
- (b) It shall be unlawful to intentionally dial the emergency telephone number “911” to report a matter which a reasonable person would recognize is not an emergency for which fire, police, or EMS services are warranted.

SECTION II: That a portion of Subsection 24.27 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City of Stevens Point, Exhibit A Schedule of Cash Deposits, is hereby **created** to read as follows:

24.01(5) Prohibited Use of 911 System.....First offense \$100.00
Second and Subsequent offense \$250.00

SECTION III: This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication, as provided by law.
