RE: Ordinance Amendment - Chapter 12.14 (13) Operator's License

BACKGROUND

State Statute 125.17 required that applications for beverage operator's license be issued by the municipal governing body. Therefore, all applications were reviewed and approved by committee and council.

SUMMARY

On March 3, 2020, the State approved Wisconsin Act 166 amending the statute to provide the municipal governing body, by ordinance, the authority to designate an official to issue operator's licenses. Allowing the Clerk to directly issue operator's licenses would streamline the process from the time of request to mailing the license. Chapter 12, Section 14 has been revised to designate the City Clerk as the municipal official for issuance of operator's licenses.

RECOMMENDATION

Approve the Chapter 12.14(13) ordinance amendment as presented.

* Section 991.11, WISCONSIN STATUTES: Effective date of acts. "Every act and every portion of an act enacted by the legislature over the governor's partial veto which does not expressly prescribe the time when it takes effect shall take effect on the day after its date of publication."

2019 WISCONSIN ACT 166

AN ACT *to amend* 125.17 (1), 125.17 (4) (intro.), 125.17 (5) (b), 125.17 (6) (a) (intro.) and 125.17 (6) (b) of the statutes; **relating to:** issuance by municipalities of alcohol beverage operator's licenses.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 125.17 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

125.17 (1) **AUTHORIZATION.** Every municipal governing body shall issue an operator's license to any applicant who is qualified under s. 125.04 (5), except that the municipal governing body may by ordinance authorize a designated municipal official to issue operator's licenses. Operators' licenses may not be required other than for the purpose of complying with ss. 125.32 (2) and 125.68 (2) or s. 125.06 (3g). Operators' licenses may be issued only upon written application.

SECTION 2. 125.17 (4) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:

125.17 (4) **TEMPORARY LICENSE.** (intro.) Any municipal governing body or designated municipal official may issue a temporary operator's license under the terms of subs. (1) to (3), except that:

SECTION 3. 125.17 (5) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

125.17 (5) (b) A provisional license may be issued only to a person who has applied for an operator's license under sub. (1). A provisional license may not be issued to any person who has been denied a license under sub. (1) by the municipal governing body or designated municipal official.

SECTION 4. 125.17 (6) (a) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:

125.17 (6) (a) (intro.) Except as provided in par. (b), no municipal governing body or designated municipal official may issue an operator's license unless the applicant has successfully completed a responsible beverage server training course at any location that is offered by a technical college district and that conforms to curriculum guidelines specified by the technical college system board or a comparable training course, which may include computer-based training and testing, that is approved by the department or the department of safety and professional services, or unless the applicant fulfills one of the following requirements:

SECTION 5. 125.17 (6) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

125.17 (6) (b) A municipal governing body or designated municipal official shall issue a provisional operator's license to a person who is enrolled in a training course under par. (a) and who meets the standards established by the municipality by ordinance, if any. The municipal governing body shall revoke that license if the applicant fails successfully to complete the course in which he or she enrolls.

**ORDINANCE AMENDING THE REVISED MUNICIPAL CODE
OF THE CITY OF STEVENS POINT, WISCONSIN**

The Common Council of the City of Stevens Point, do ordain as follows:

SECTION I. Subsection (13) of Section 12.14 of the Municipal Code of the City of Stevens Point, is hereby amended to read as follows:

12.14 (13) Operator's License

(a) New Applications. The City Clerk shall be the designated municipal official for issuance of operator's licenses under Wis. Stats § 125.17. New applicants for an operator's license shall be issued a provisional license by the eCity eClerk in accordance with Section 125.17(5), Wisconsin statutes, if all other conditions of Section 125.04(5) of the Statutes have been met, until the responsible beverage server training course requirements have been fulfilled, but not to exceed 60 days from date of issuance. The provisional and regular license fee is set forth in Section 12.00. Upon successful completion of the training course, a regular operator's license shall be issued by the city clerk at no additional cost, to expire on June 30th following issuance. Persons failing to complete such course within 60 days may apply for no more than one additional provisional license within the license year upon payment of another fee.

(b) Renewal Applications. Holders of regular operators licenses may apply for renewal. Renewal licenses shall expire on the second June 30th following issuance of such license. The renewal license fee is set forth in Section 12.00.

(c) Applicants for Operator's License (New or Renewal) shall truthfully answer all questions on the application form provided by the City Clerk and sign such. In the event the applicant fails to complete the form, or does not answer fully, the Clerk ~~will not forward such application to the Common Council~~ shall not issue the license. The applicant shall be notified of the omissions and may submit a new form after a waiting period of sixty days, and remit a new fee. If the applicant does not meet all of the lawful qualifications for issuance of a license, the Clerk shall not issue the license and shall provide the applicant a written document indicating the reasons for such denial. An applicant may appeal such denial by filing a request in writing for a hearing before the Common Council. Such hearing and any further appeal from the decision rendered following such hearing shall be governed by Wis. Stats. § 125.12.

SECTION II: This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication, as provided by law.
