Congratulations! On behalf of the Governor, we are pleased to forward to you a grant agreement for financial assistance for your Urban Wildlife Damage Abatement and Control Project.

Please review the agreement and return a copy signed by the authorized official **within 30 days of this letter's date** to Wendy Peich at the Bureau of Community Financial Assistance, 101 S Webster St, Madison, WI 53707. Your grant is not official until you have returned the signed copy. Please read the items checked below. They apply to your project and grant award.

- **Grant Award Time Period: Date you sign the award agreement through January 27, 2023.** All project activities must occur within this time period to be eligible costs for reimbursement.
- **Advance or Reimbursement Check:** Your advance or reimbursement check will be mailed to City of Stevens Point, Mike Wiza, 1515 Strongs Avenue, Stevens Point, WI 54481. Please notify us if this is not the correct person to receive checks.
- **Important Change Regarding Payment:** As of this year, grant payments will now be sent via ACH transfer (electronic bank transfer), as opposed to the physical checks mailed to you in the past. ACH payments are an efficient, secure payment method and will reduce the amount of time it takes to receive payment from DNR. As your requests are approved, you will receive an email to notify you that payment will arrive shortly. When the ACH transfer occurs, your county treasurer will receive an email from the State of Wisconsin with payment details, including a "memo" with details on the project to help them process the payment appropriately.
- **Changes to the approved project scope** may not be made without prior approval from the Department.

Be sure to also submit your final report of activities for the grant project along with the reimbursement request forms.
