DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS REPORT

1. Engineering Division

- **Sidewalk Continuation**
 - Staff has completed the finalization of a sidewalk prioritization model and is working to finalize a draft of the Sidewalk Continuation Plan report.
- **Stanley Street at North Point Drive Intersection Improvements:**
 - Staff recently discussed the project with WisDOT. WisDOT provided several comments on the Intersection Control Evaluation Report and staff will be meeting with AECOM in preparation of finalizing the report.
- **TAP Grant**
 - All work related to the TAP Grant is complete.
 - Staff continues to work on finalizing the project, including working with the DOT on reimbursements.
- **East Park Commerce Center**
 - With the weather being cooperative, the contractor has indicated that they will be resuming work later this month.
- **Country Club Drive**
 - Nothing new to report.
- **Business 51 (Division and Church Streets) Reconstruction**
 - The project team continues to review the public comments and evaluate alternatives as we work towards a recommended alternative.
- **2020 Street Improvement Project**
 - All work has been completed. The contractor will return in the spring to address any remaining punch list items and warranty issues.
- **2020 Road Resurfacing Project**
 - All work has been completed. The contractor will return in the spring to address any remaining punch list items and warranty issues.

- **McDill Monitoring and Control Project**
 - The contract with Van Ert has been executed and construction of the control panel has begun.
 - Panel construction will likely take several months.
- **2020 Alley Improvement Project**
 - Engineering staff is working with American Asphalt on asphalt mix designs and repair approaches so that we can maximize not only the amount of alley improvement we may be able to accomplish, but to also ensure longevity of the improvements.
 - Staff is anticipates having a project out for bid later this spring.
- **2020 Fall Paving Project**
 - Streets and Utility Staff are working together to touch of the swales along Kozy Street as may be necessary by placing additional topsoil and grass seed.
- **2021 Road Resurfacing Project**
 - The bid opening for the resurfacing project was held on Tuesday, March 30, 2021.
 - A total of 5 bids were received.
 - The lowest responsible bid was submitted by Merrill Gravel and Construction Co. in the amount of \$1,300,251.21.
 - Staff is recommending awarding the project to Merrill Gravel and Construction Co. in an amount not to exceed \$1,495,288.89.
- **2021 Streets Improvement Project**
 - The bid opening for the Streets Improvement project was held on Tuesday, March 16, 2021.
 - A total of 4 bids were received.
 - The lowest responsible bid was submitted by Gerke Excavating Inc. in the amount of \$6,239,260.62.
 - Staff is recommending awarding the project to Gerke Excavating, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$7,175,149.71.
- **Plover River Crossing Trail Project**
 - The geotechnical report is complete, and Rettler/AECOM are evaluating the findings to determine suitable foundation designs.
 - Rettler is reviewing both horizontal and vertical alignments of the proposed trail route to comply with the Wisconsin Bicycle Facility Design Handbook as well as to minimize environmental impacts and meet applicable ADA standards.
- **Additional Miscellaneous Projects:**
 - The Engineering Department continues to work on improving the data management for public information as well as internally for decision making and planning for future capital projects.
 - Public Works is working in collaboration with Sara Brish at the Stevens Point Area Convention and Visitors Bureau on the replacement of existing wayfinding signs.
 - Sara has acquired grant funding to assist with the cost of purchasing the signs.
 - Engineering Staff continues gathering survey data and researching right of way

- for proposed 2021 and 2022 roadway projects.
- Over the past few years staff have been actively working on replacing older energy consuming street lighting and that effort continues in 2021.
 - Staff has identified several areas for LED lighting upgrades which should be completed later this year.
- Staff will be setting up traffic counting cameras over the next few weeks at various intersection throughout the City to update traffic counts for intersections of interest.

Re: Contract Award Recommendation
2021 Streets Improvement Project #21-01

Bids for the 2021 Streets Improvement Project were received on March 16, 2021. A total of four bids were received, ranging from approximately \$6.2 million to \$7.9 million. The bids are summarized in the attached bid tabulation.

Bidding was very competitive with the two lowest bids separated by less than 7 percent. The lowest bid was submitted by Gerke Excavating, Inc. out of Tomahawk, WI. Gerke's bid is also within the engineering estimate for the project. While we have not worked with Gerke in the past we have been reviewed their qualifications and believe that they are a responsible bidder. Based upon their available resources and past projects staff believes they are qualified and capable of performing the work.

It is staff's recommendation that the project be awarded to Gerke Excavating, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$7,175,149.71, including a 15 percent contingency.

Bids for the Road Resurfacing Project were received on March 30, 2021. The bidding was very competitive with five bids being received. The bids were very close ranging from approximately \$1.3 million to \$1.45 million. A summary of the bids is found in the attached bid tabulation.

The bids were very competitive, with the lowest bid submitted by Merrill Gravel and Construction, Co. out of Merrill, WI. Merrill's bid was within the Engineering estimate and we staff believes the Merrill is qualified and capable of performing the work. Merrill was a subcontractor to American Asphalt on the roundabout project back in 2018 and performed very well.

It is staff's recommendation that the project be awarded to Merrill Gravel and Construction Co. in an amount not to exceed \$1,495,288.89, including a 15 percent contingency.

**ORDINANCE AMENDING THE REVISED MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF

The Common Council of the City of Stevens Point do ordain as follows:

SECTION I: That Subsection 9.19 of the Revised Municipal Code, ATV/UTV Routes, is hereby **created** to read as follows:

9.19 ATV/UTV ROUTES

- (1) Pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 23.33(11), the operation of all-terrain vehicles and utility terrain vehicles is authorized upon the following sections of roadway within the City of Stevens Point
- (i) West River Drive from the West city limits to West Clark Street/STH 66.
 - (ii) West Clark Street/STH 66 from West River Drive to a point 50 feet west of West Whitney Street.
 - (iii) That part of Stanley Street located within the city limits from North Court to Wilshire Boulevard North.
 - (iv) That part of Wilshire Boulevard North located within the city limits from Stanley Street to North Point Drive.
 - (v) That part of Torun Road located within the city limits from Norway Pine Drive to the North city limits.
 - (vi) Brilowski Road from a point 375 feet north of Main Street/USH 10 to the North city limits.
 - (vii) That part of Old Highway 18 Road located within the city limits from a point 250 feet south of Main Street/USH 10 to Brilowski Road.

SECTION II: This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication, as provided by law.

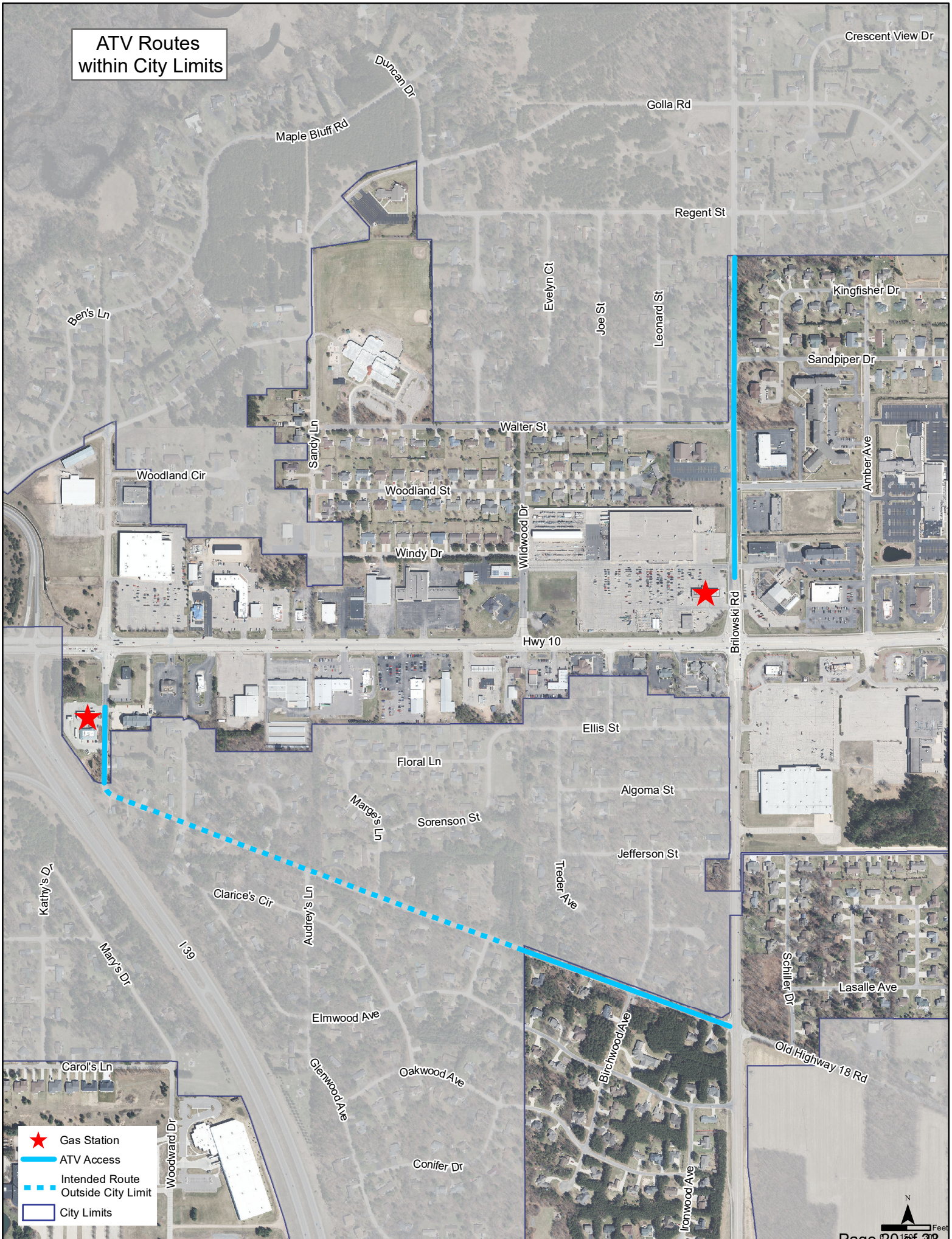

9.05 (l) All Night Parking Regulated

1. Except within the Downtown District as described in Section 2. below, alternate side parking regulations shall be in effect on all streets within the City of Stevens Point between the hours of 2:30 AM and 6:00 AM.

Such regulations shall apply as follows:

A. On odd-numbered days, vehicles shall only be parked, stopped or left standing on that side of the street having odd-numbered addresses.

B. On even-numbered days, vehicles shall only be parked, stopped or left standing on that side of the street having even-numbered addresses.

Overnight parking requirements shall apply to corresponding calendar date as of 2:30 AM.

2. Downtown District - The Downtown District shall be identified as indicated on the attached map labeled On-Street Overnight Parking Downtown. No person shall park any vehicle between the hours of 2:30 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on any street or parking lot in the Downtown District with the following exemption:

(i) Overnight parking will be allowed by permit in Lot 7, Lot 12, and Lot 16.

(ii) The cost to obtain a permit will be \$3.00 per night

(iii) Permits can be purchase online or via kiosks located in lot 12 and lot 16.

(3) These rules do not replace more restrictive parking regulations in the City including any posted No Parking zones, no parking restrictions created under state statute, restrictions for parking near fire hydrants or other City infrastructure, snow emergency parking restrictions, or during times when snow has not been plowed from the designated parking area.

(4) Exemptions. Exceptions to the overnight parking rules may be created as follows:

(i) Emergency Parking. Medical professionals responding to emergency situations may park as needed to best perform their duties.

(ii) Mayoral Order. During special events, occurrences or circumstances which the Mayor authorizes an exemption for overnight parking by executive order. No such exception shall last for a period greater than 96 hours without approval by the Common Council.

(iii) Common Council Authorization. As authorized or permitted by the Common Council.

(iv) Other Departmental Authorization. Any authorization granted by the Chief of Police or the Director of Public Works or the respective designee of either, pursuant to a policy adopted by that department.

(5) Overnight parking is limited to motorized vehicles that have current registration and must be operable. Recreational vehicles (RV) are restricted from overnight parking unless granted prior authorization from the Chief of Police or his/her designee.

(i) Trailers. Trailers of any type shall not be parked overnight unless attached to a motor vehicle. Vehicles with trailers of any type attached shall not be parked overnight more than 3 consecutive nights.
